Dear First Presbyterian Church Family,

Greetings to you all. We hope this letter finds you all safe and hopeful for the joy that coming back together in person will give.

Your Session has been meeting every two weeks to ensure the church continues to serve the purpose God has given to us here in North Bend/Coos Bay. As such we continue to discern and pray for God's guidance while we weigh the decision to come back together in person. As of today, we still do not feel comfortable having everyone return to inperson worship. Here are the three main reasons that have guided this decision. First, the complicated nature of not knowing for sure that we could keep everyone safe in our building. Because the majority of our membership fits inside the most vulnerable population category, and because there is still much we do not know about this virus, we do not want to risk your health and well-being by returning too early. Second, even in an attempt to create a safe environment, choices for who can and cannot come to worship would have to be made, and no one on Session wants to be the one who has to make those decisions. For additional information contact one of your Elders or the Church office. Finally, your Session wants our eventual return to in-person worship to be as joyful as possible and include as many of us as possible. God's Church here at First Presbyterian is not the building but the people, and we want our homecoming to be reflected in that collection of people that have gathered here year after year to give honor and praise to our God. Waiting for that day is more important to us than rushing back and risking more.

Also, as of July 1, 2020, in accordance with the current mandate by the State of Oregon, and in our best attempt to help stop the transmission of Covid 19, anyone entering our church building to work or volunteer must follow the guidance that mandates wearing face coverings (mask and/or face shield).
